

- III. In addition to the above, the approved copy of bylaws, all amendments to the bylaws will be filed in the back of the secretary's permanent record book
- IV. Attends to all correspondences
- V. Shall have no voting rights

D. Treasurer

- I. Receives all monies of OVYFL league
- II. Keeps an accurate record of the receipts and expenditures, and payout funds under the direction of the league board.
- III. The funds acquired by the league shall be deposited in a federally insured financial institution approved by the league board.
- IV. Shall present a statement of account at every league meeting
- V. An auditing committee of not less than (2) members will be appointed at least two weeks before the last league meeting by the President with the approval of the OVYFL board to examine the treasurer's accounts at the end of each football season.
- VI. Shall be bonded.
- VII. Shall have no voting right, unless they represent their respective organization.

E. Seargant of Arms

- I. Insures the meetings are ran in an orderly fashion.
- II. Has the ability to ask anyone to leave the meeting for being disruptive

- 5. An official league meeting cannot be held without a Quorum of members, or their approved substitutes present.
- 6. All League rules and changes must be voted on by a majority of the members of the board.
- 7. A representative from each organization must be present at all league meetings. If there is an absence, the organization will receive a verbal warning. If there is a second absence, the organization will be issued a written warning to their President, by the League Board. If there is a third absence, the organization will forfeit their next scheduled league game.
- 8. A player must play for the district in which he/she attends school. If a player attends a private school or is home schooled, he/she must play for the district in which he/she lives. If a team is found to have a player playing for them that does not abide by this rule, that team will forfeit its entire season.
 - A. Out of district players that participate in the OVYFL and have moved from their original program are permitted to play at the program from which they came providing it is on a continual basis. At the point the child missed a season, he/she must return to the program that he/she lives in the district of (this does not include injured players that have to sit out for a year. However, they must be on the roster and weigh-in for that season.) The Board must be notified of all players and this will be done on a case-by-case basis. If the Board is not notified this child will be considered an ineligible player.
